Why are weeds a problem?

- Lower the aesthetic quality of the field
- Competition with desired turf species for resources
- Influence on playability and player safety
 Ball- and player-surface interactions
- · Shortened field longevity

Keys to Successful Weed Control

- Correct weed ID
- Knowledge of weed biology
 Annual vs perennial
- Use of cultural practices to reduce weed populations
- Proper herbicide selection, timing, and application


Weeds as Indicators

- Weed presence and frequency change over time as conditions change
- A population shift in certain weed species or large monocultures of a specific weed can indicate underlying environmental problems
- Correct weed ID is critical to determining these underlying environmental problems!























